(C) DEFENDANT STEVENS WAS ASKED FOR SOME TYPE OF IDENTIFICATION, AT WHICH TIME HE RELATED THAT IT WAS IN HIS VEHICLE. SERGEANT ARNOLDI THEN ASKED THE OTHER SUBJECT, [REDACTED] FOR HIS NAME, DATE OF BIRTH, ETC. BOTH SUBJECTS WERE THEN REQUESTED TO WALK UP TO THE ROADWAY WHERE DEFENDANT STEVENS VEHICLE (PAGE TWO, ITEM # 2) WAS PARKED. SERGEANT ARNOLDI THEN ADVISED DEFENDANT STEVENS THAT HE WAS UNDER ARREST FOR VIOLATION OF BOTH CALIFORNIA PENAL CODE SECTION 647 (a), LEWD CONDUCT IN A PUBLIC PLACE AND SANTA BARBARA COUNTY ORDINANCE 24-15, BEING NUDE IN A PUBLIC PLACE. DEFENDANT STEVENS WAS ISSUED CITATION NUMBER 56052 AND RELEASED. SERGEANT ARNOLDI THEN QUESTIONED WITNESS [REDACTED] RELATED THAT HE DID NOT OBSERVE DEFENDANT STEVENS MASTURBATING SINCE HE WAS ASLEEP. WHEN ASKED IF THE SUSPECT HAS EVER ATTEMPTED TO DO ANYTHING SEXUAL WITH HIM TODAY OR IN THE PAST, WITNESS [REDACTED] RELATED THAT HE HAD NOT. SERGEANT ARNOLDI ALSO ASKED WITNESS [REDACTED] IF HE FELT COMFORTABLE BEING DRIVEN/RETURNED HOME BY DEFENDANT STEVENS, OF WHICH WITNESS [REDACTED] SAID "YES", THAT IT WAS NOT PROBLEM. BOTH WITNESS [REDACTED] AND SUSPECT STEVENS WERE ADVISED THAT SERGEANT ARNOLDI WAS GOING TO TELEPHONE EITHER MR. [REDACTED], [REDACTED] FATHER, OR MRS. [REDACTED] MOTHER, AND ADVISE THEM OF WHAT DEPUTIES HAD OBSERVED. BOTH SUBJECTS UNDERSTOOD, AT WHICH TIME THEY WERE RELEASED TO RETURN TO LOMPOC. DEFENDANT STEVENS CONCLUDED BY SAYING, "I HAVE NEVER DONE ANYTHING LIKE THIS BEFORE". AT WHICH TIME HE RETURNED TO HIS VEHICLE AND DROVE OFF. SERGEANT ARNOLDI THEN TELEPHONED THE [REDACTED] RESIDENCE AT 1740 HOURS AND ADVISED MRS. [REDACTED] OF THE OFFENSE AND THAT HE SON, [REDACTED], WAS A WITNESS TO THIS CRIME. MRS. [REDACTED] THEN RELATED THAT SHE KNEW THAT HER SON WAS OUT WITH DEFENDANT STEVENS, BUT, DID NOT KNOW THEIR LOCATION. WHEN ADVISED THAT HE SON FELT COMFORTABLE

8. (C) I re-interviewed [REDACTED] at his residence. [REDACTED] indicated that concerning the day of 6-29-91, he had gone to Red Rock with Terrence STEVENS for a day of fun and relaxation. He was the only one that attended with STEVENS, and this was only the second time he had gone to Red Rock with STEVENS. [REDACTED] indicates he fell asleep on a rock, and was awakened by STEVENS who was packing his things up. STEVENS told [REDACTED] he had to go, and [REDACTED] then awakened and started to get ready. STEVENS walked away approaching two Sheriff's deputies standing on the road above. After [REDACTED] went to the road, he was advised by the deputy with glasses that STEVENS had been masturbating in front of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said that he was asleep during this time, and did not see STEVENS masturbating. [REDACTED] is familiar with what masturbating is. [REDACTED] mentioned that he has never STEVENS do anything like this before, and mentioned that he was shocked when this was reported to him by the deputy.

21. [REDACTED] says the only other time he went up to Red Rock with STEVENS was when he and STEVENS accompanied STEVENS' parents to Red Rock along with STEVENS nephew, [REDACTED]. The nephews along with STEVENS parents spent the night, and [REDACTED] returned with STEVENS that day.

26. [REDACTED] says he knows STEVENS from A.Y.S.O. soccer where STEVENS coached the team that [REDACTED] was on in the 6'th grade. It was approximately three years ago that he first met him, when [REDACTED] was eleven.

The last two years [REDACTED] has played on a club soccer league with the C.Y.S.A. He played for the Strikers one season and for Lompoc United the second season, both times with STEVENS as the coach. [REDACTED] could not get rides to tournaments most of the time as his parents were too busy, so STEVENS would give him rides. [REDACTED] was the only one that he would give rides to all the time, though occasionally other kids on the team would get rides. The assistant coach for the team was an [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] or something to that effect. He thought that [REDACTED] lived across the street from Buena Vista School in the Village. [REDACTED] states of all the kids on the teams, [REDACTED] was the best friend of STEVENS.

CONFIDENTIAL

[REDACTED] states however he has never spent the night at STEVENS residence, and doesn't know of anyone who has. STEVENS has never done anything off color in front of or around [REDACTED], and he knows of no statements by anyone else indicating that he has. He is shocked as to what STEVENS allegedly did, but personally did not see it.

He doesn't know of anyone else who has gone to Red Rock with STEVENS, and doesn't know about any other trips STEVENS may have taken with people other than trips to tournaments. In the final phase of the interview I asked [REDACTED] if he thought STEVENS was gay. [REDACTED] said he did not because STEVENS flirts with a girl named Sheila. He knew nothing else about Sheila.

I then interviewed Mrs [REDACTED]. She says that she is upset as to what happened and is not allowing her son to associate with STEVENS any more. Mrs [REDACTED] stated that STEVENS has not called the house since he dropped off [REDACTED] and has not visited the house either. [REDACTED] confirmed he has not heard from STEVENS since this event.

I had since been advised by Deputy Garhart of the Santa Barbara station

1. that a acquaintance of his had reported to him concerns about the rumors she had
 2. heard. The acquaintance, [REDACTED], had mentioned to Deputy Gerhart that
 3. she had heard from another friend in the church that STEVENS was involved in some
 4. sort of child molest investigation. [REDACTED]'s sons were on STEVENS team, and
 5. allegedly STEVENS called [REDACTED]'s son [REDACTED] and questioned him as to where the
 6. rumor was coming from and who was spreading it. [REDACTED] was uncomfortable about the
 7. call from STEVENS, and was also concerned about STEVENS continued coaching. She
 8. registered some concerns that she had had for some time to Gerhart about STEVENS
 9. closeness to the children, and Gerhart suggested I question [REDACTED].

10. I called her on the phone on July 17 and just briefly spoke to her about what she
 11. knew about. [REDACTED] said she has always been alarmed with regard to STEVENS, and
 12. has never allowed her son to interact with him other than at games and at practices.
 13. She said she has just had an uncomfortable feeling around him since the time she first
 14. met him. Her son was in a soccer league several years ago, and she met STEVENS
 15. first as a referee for games. She noticed that every time STEVENS refereed a game,
 16. a young friend of his was always with him. This young friend was [REDACTED].
 17. Later on STEVENS became the coach of the All-Star team for one of her sons. During
 18. the time that he was the All-Star coach, he always had one of the boys on the team
 19. with him also. However this was a different boy, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] would be picked
 20. up for games and practices by STEVENS constantly, and would often spend the night
 21. at STEVENS home. STEVENS also developed an inner circle of players who hung out
 22. with him, while other kids on the team were ignored by him. [REDACTED] stated that
 23. her one son was one of the stars of the team, but because he didn't hang out with
 24. STEVENS he was ignored by the team. She started to hear derogatory sexual comments
 25. made by STEVENS to his friends, the small children, when they were in the nine year
 26. old age group. This confirmed some of her fears and made her feel uncomfortable with
 27. STEVENS as a coach.

2. During the time that they were in the All-Star league, there was a trip to a tournament

3. in Camarillo that took place. It was in 1989, and STEVENS had requested that most of

4. the kids go with him and spend the day at Magic Mountain the day before the tournament,

5. have a sleep-over and then go to the tournament the next morning. [redacted] already

6. had an uncomfortable feeling about STEVENS, but also felt this was odd for a coach

7. to want to do. Tournaments are very trying on the stamina on the young children, and

8. going to Magic Mountain the day before would only wear the kids out. Nonetheless the

9. trip took place, though most parents kept their kids with them. There were several

10. that did go to Magic Mountain and spent the night with STEVENS at STEVENS brother's

11. house in Valencia. She knows one to be [redacted], and believes the others were [redacted]

12. and [redacted] though she is not certain.

14. Following the hearing of the rumor, she spoke to her son [redacted] about when he

15. played for STEVENS. [redacted] said that he was not in the special group, and was uncomfortable

16. with those people in the group, so he really didn't know what went on. She has spoken

17. to other friends who mentioned to her that they also were concerned about STEVENS

18. apparent overwhelming interest in young boys, which seems to go well beyond his

19. simple interest in sports. She has also spoken to the mother of [redacted] and [redacted]

1. good friend, plays also for Cabrillo HS team. Following that STEVENS called [redacted]
2. at home and questioned him about spreading the rumor. He wanted to know who told him
3. about the rumor, and advised [redacted] that it was all a lie.

5. I then asked [redacted] what the rumor was that she heard. She said that
6. STEVENS was allegedly found molesting a 14 year old boy at Red Rock. I told her
7. that that rumor was in fact not true. I said that he was found with a 14 year old
8. boy and he was cited for nudity in public, and there is an investigation going on
9. concerning other issues, but at this time he is not accused of actually molesting
10. the boy.

12. This investigator did a similar investigation involving Terrence STEVENS in
13. where the alleged victim was [redacted]. [redacted] was interviewed at the time
14. and revealed no information concerning any inproprieties by Terrence STEVENS. Terrence
